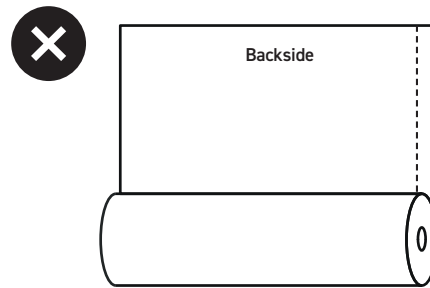
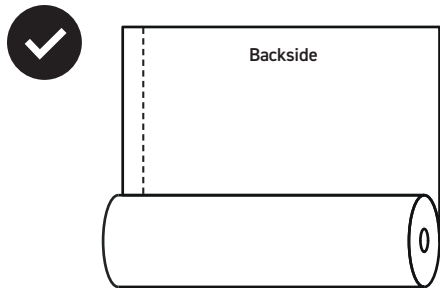


# Savoy handling instructions

Savoy is a velvet fabric that requires proper handling in order to retain its quality. These instructions list the various ways in which the handling of Savoy differs from that of Gabriel's other products. If you have any questions, please contact [QEP@gabriel.dk](mailto:QEP@gabriel.dk).

## Pile direction indicator

This product has a vertical pile direction. The direction of the pile is indicated by a black and white thread on the left-hand side of the fabric roll. If the pile direction indicator is on the right, the fabric must be rerolled immediately, as described in the rolling instructions below. Storing the fabric rolled against the pile direction will degrade the quality of the fabric.

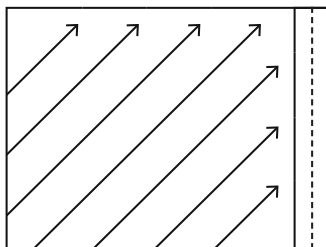


## Frontside facing outwards

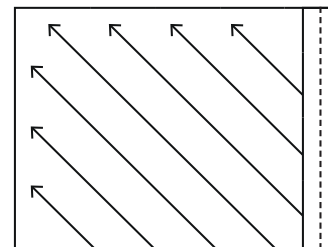
The fabric is rolled with the frontside facing outwards.

## Horizontal pile direction

As well as the vertical pile direction, the product also has a horizontal pile direction. Depending on the inflow of light, visual differences may be present. The last digit of the roll-ID identifies the horizontal pile direction. Even numbers (0-2-4-6-8) represent one pile direction, while odd numbers (1-3-5-7-9) represent the other.



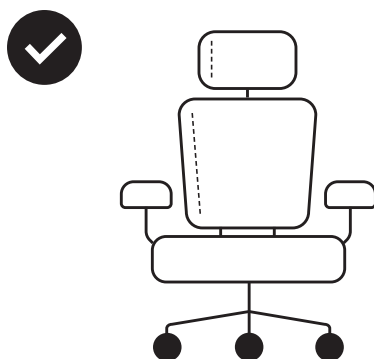

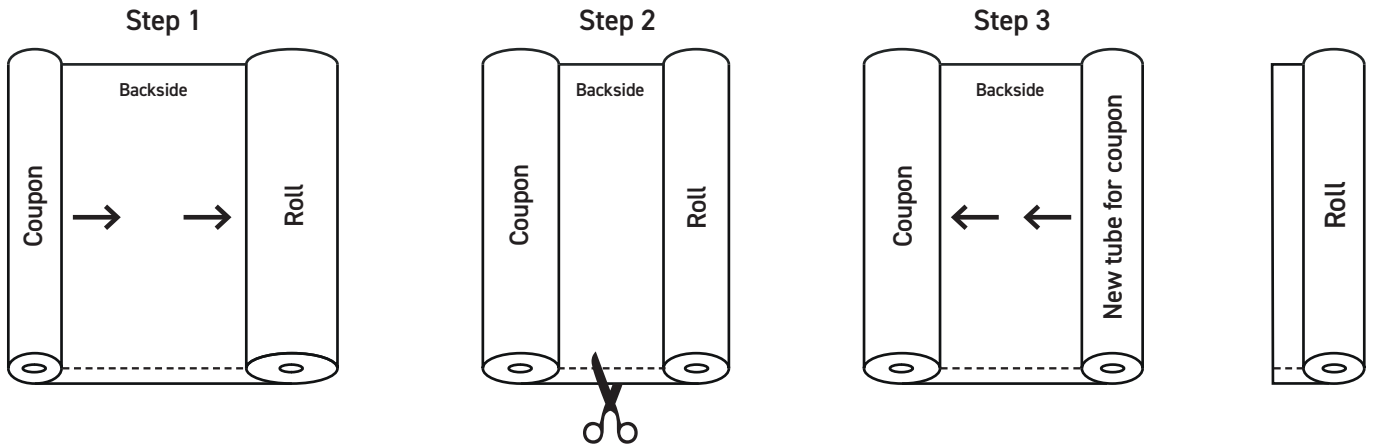
## Pile direction in upholstery

Different pile directions will reflect light in different ways. It is therefore important to maintain the same pile direction on adjacent surfaces in order to assure a similar visual appearance.



### Rolling instructions

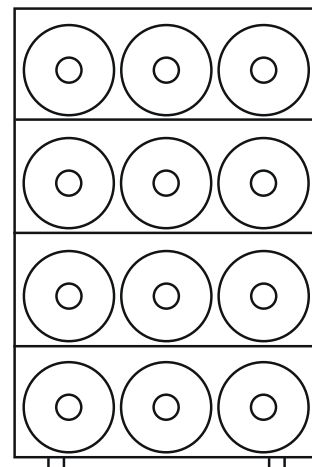
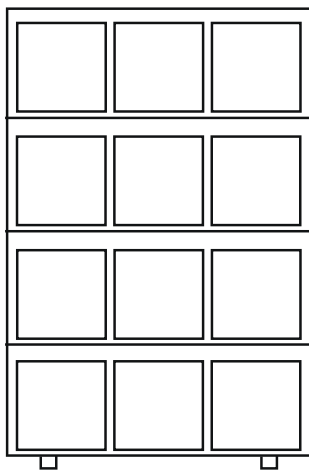
When cutting a coupon, it is important to preserve the pile direction. This requires an additional rerolling of the coupon onto a new tube after cutting. This is illustrated in three steps below.



### Store rolls in boxes (only applies to fabrics sent in boxes)

In order to avoid pressmarks on the fabric, Gabriel supplies rolls  $\geq 10$  meters of this fabric in specially designed boxes with an internal suspension system. It is important to retain the suspended storage in the boxes, in order to avoid pressmarks.

If you ordered a coupon below 10 meters, the fabric is supplied without a box. It is still important to reduce pressure on these rolls by not stacking fabrics on top of each other.



### Vacuum cleaning the fabric

By nature, velour may attract fibres. Just as for other fabrics, Gabriel recommends regular vacuum cleaning of the fabric.
